2024 Annual General Meeting



On Thursday 11 April 2024, Freemasons on the Central Coast held their Annual General Meeting.

All current Directors were in attendance and they were extremely please to also welcome five members along with our guests, Ms Tia Covi and and Mr Tyler Williams.

During the meeting the Treasurer was pleased to announce the total amount donated in 2023 was \$135,828, more than double last years total of \$73,649.

The financial assistance Freemasons on the Central Coast provides supports various community organisations within the Central Coast Local Government Area; we rarely donate funds directly to the organisation but rather purchase items and services required by the recipient organisation.
