This programme commenced approximately four years ago within the Central Coast SLS Clubs and has been a defining moment for many families. Their child is introduced to the surf and taught basic survival techniques. This action has allowed all members of the family to attend the beach.

Freemasons on the Central Coast commenced their sponsorship initially with Soldiers Beach SLS Club by purchasing the Surf Boat '**The Freemason**' as well as an IRB.

In addition, **Freemasons on the Central Coast** have sponsored the purchase of IRBs for Toowoon Bay and Terrigal (2) SLSCs, surf skis, oars for a surf boat, rescue boards for Umina Beach, assisted Killcare SLSC, assisted with Callipoli venture by Soldiers Beach SLSC as well as raising money at Avoca Beach for the repair/ replacement of items for the community when severe storms hit the Central Coast beaches several years ago.
